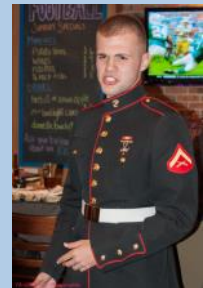
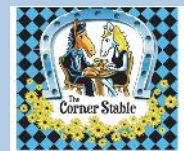
Chapter Activities
